Street Sign Project

Our Leadership Shelby County Class of 2022-2023 was tasked with developing a project to make a positive impact on Shelby County. Our specific group created a plan to update several of the intersection street signs throughout Shelbyville to incorporate local schools to create a sense of unity within the community. We decided that with the redesign of the downtown Square, updated street signs may also contribute to a more updated feel to the town - along with an opportunity to show support for our elementary, middle, and high schools.

Our group created a list of intersections throughout Shelbyville, counted the signs we would like to update, and created mockups displaying each school's (Loper, Hendricks, Coulston, St. Joe, and Shelbyville Middle and High School) mascot.

We had several meetings with the School Board, Planning Commission, and Street Department along the way to determine if this was feasible, to determine a potential timeline, and an estimated cost. Although we initially planned to update 36 street signs with a fundraising target of \$3,000, we were able to surpass that goal. In the end, we were able to adjust the sizing of our signs, raised \$5,100, and used the additional \$1,000 provided by the program to fund a total of 175 signs.
